Bulletin Board FLU SEASON IS BACK! SCHEDULE YOUR VACCINE NOW This year CMG will offer both the live attenuated flu vaccine (Flumist), given as a nasal spray; and the killed virus vaccine, Fluzone, given as an injection to our patients and caregivers of our patients under 6 months old. The vaccine can be given during a scheduled appointment with their doctor, or parents can schedule an appointment during one of our flu vaccine clinics. Flu vaccine clinics will be held between the hours of 9a.m. and noon and 2-3:15p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays starting in mid-September. A flu clinic appointment will be with a nurse only; patients will not see a doctor at the time of the appointment. Patients under 18 must be accompanied by a parent to the appointment. Call our office after September 1 to schedule a flu vaccine appointment. CMG follows the recommendations of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Centers of Disease Control regarding flu vaccination for people six months and older.
